MEBC CORPORATE MENTORING PROGRAM



OBJECTIVE

Created to strengthen the link between the yachting industry & the university teams participating in the Monaco Energy Boat Challenge, the mentoring program aims at providing guidance to the teams from industry experts.

As in In Homer's Odyssey, Mentor is Telemachus's wise friend, providing him with advice and assistance.

The mentor will be assisting students in building their crafts / concepts, striving for innovation and helping them develop their focus on an engaging design for the MEBC 2023.

The 2023 Mentor Program will initiate in February 2023 and will finish on July 8th 2023.

Which organisation can be part of the MEBC Corporate Mentoring Program:


- The organisation should be an active member of the yachting industry.
- The organisation should be engaged toward sustainability in yachting.
- The organisation engage itself to provide support to the assigned team for the duration of the program.
- The organisation should assign one mentor for the team which will be their referent throughout the mentoring program.

Who can be a mentor:

- A member of the organisation holding technical knowledge to be able to assist teams in their project development.
- The mentor should understand the rules of the challenge to be able to assist the team with their application & project. (Notice of Race & Technical Rule).
- The mentor should have at least one of these areas of expertise/interest: ship design, ship building, energy efficiency, sustainability, R&D, new material, alternative propulsion system...

MENTORING PROGRAM OBLIGATIONS

- The mentor should meet (remotely or in person) at least **once a month** with the team it is assigned to.
- The mentor should assist the team in their goal to succeed in the challenge without judgement.
- The mentor and mentee should agree on a mentoring planning & communication procedure.
- The mentee team should partake in the program with an open mind and should put its best effort to benefit from the professional advice.
- The mentee team should not expect the mentor to do any work for them.
- If the mentor or the team mentee should feel that at any time the mentoring program is not appropriately taking place it has to be referred in writing to energychallenge@ycm.org
- A closure feedback questionnaire will be provided to both the mentor and mentee team to evaluate the experience & allow improvements to the mentoring program.
